Richard reported on the activities of the Board of Directors.

Herb Schwab, Secretary/Treasurer

Herb reported that the Southern Zone account balance is \$6,802.24.

Brian Dangelmaier, Age Group Chair

Brian reported that he needs to form a Meet Evaluation Committee. The Committee is composed of these members:

There were 525 athletes from 13 LSCs participating in the Age Group Championships. There were 3 disability athletes. Thirty-five meet records were set. There were 72 Short Course National Cuts achieved, along with 14 Junior cuts, and 12 US Open cuts.

Brian showed pictures from the meet. He thanked the YMCA Aquatic Center Staff, Gay Wright (Meet Director), Helen Kelly (Florida Swimming), Stu Michelson (Meet Referee), Gloria Schuldt, and Melissa Hellervik-Bing.

Florida Swimming finished in first place in the Combined Team Scores, the Girls Team Scores, and the Boys Team Scores. Louisiana Swimming won the Charlene Craddock Sportsmanship Award.

The Open Water meet was held in the pool, due to health concerns with the lake venue. There were 214 athletes from 7 LSCs participating. Thanks to the Meet Referee, Matt Wilson. Kentucky Swimming was first in the Combined Team Scores. Gulf Swimming was first in the Girls, and Kentucky Swimming was first in the Boys Team Scores.

Clark Hammond, Officials Chair

Clark was unable to attend the Convention this year, due to work commitments. Richard gave Clark's report. Clark would like to run again as the Officials Chair. Clark also thinks that there should be term limits for this position. He suggests that this position should run parallel with the Non-Coach Zone Director position. Thus, he would like to suggest that the term be extended one year at which time he would rotate off. He also suggested that we limit the term for two periods or 4 years straight. Then the Officials Chair should rotate off for at least a year.

Hannah Wilson, Athlete Representative

Hannah asked that the athletes meet with her after this meeting is adjourned. She is trying to find ways to communicate with the athletes in the Zone. She has tried using Facebook without much success, since LSC representatives change and e-mail addresses change. She also asked how the Sectional Meets were during the past year. There were some complaints about the Eastern Sectional meet, with two pools running at the same time, causing some false starts.

2009 Southern Zone Senior Championships, Kate Chronic

Kate is the chair of the Task Force created to conduct and evaluate the Senior Zone Championships. There were 75 athletes competing in the meet, from 9 LSCs, for a total number of 330 individual entries and 16 relay entries. Each Prelim session started at 9 a.m. and finished approximately between 10:30 and 11:00 a.m. Due to the number athletes, a 15-20 minute break was held after each stroke series for Prelims and Finals. Each Finals session started at 5 p.m. finishing approximately between 6:30 and 7 p.m.

As decided at the 2008 Convention, this Task Force will remain in place and meet to discuss and evaluate the meet, and suggest any changes necessary for 2010.

2010 Southern Zone Age Group Championship Dates The meet will be held at the Georgia Tech Aquatic Center in Atlanta, from July 27 – July 31 (4½ Days), with Open Water on August 1, 2010.

2011 Southern Zone Age Group Championships Dates and Site Nominations/Presentation There were three bids submitted for the 2011 Age Group Championships:
North Carolina
North Texas
Florida State University

North Carolina's bid was presented by Wayne Shulby. The meet would be held at the Triangle Aquatic Center in Cary, North Carolina. The pool has run other large quality meets, such as the National Black Heritage '09, the Speedo Series SE Sectionals '09, the Greater Raleigh meet, the Virginia Long Course Senior Championships '08 and '09. There is spectator seating for 1000. The pool is 8 lanes, with depths varying from 9 to 14 ft. There is a 10 lane 25 yard warm-up/warm-down pool. There are spacious locker rooms and deck space, convenient free parking, complimentary wireless Internet. The venue is adjacent to the Cary Towne Center Mall. The meet would be hosted by the Raleigh Swimming Association. The venue is easily accessible by ground or air travel. The Open Water competition would be held in either of two lakes that are both within 15 minutes of the pool venue.

North Texas' bid was presented by Gloria Schuldt. The championships would be held in a brand new facility built by the Rockwall Independent School District. The pool is a 50 meter indoor pool. It has seating for 1000 spectators. There are movable bleachers on deck that would seat 800-900 athletes. The timing system is a Daktronics system. The venue is located northeast of Dallas. There are plenty of hotels and restaurants in the vicinity. The Open Water competition would be held in either Lake Carrollton or Lake Ray Hubbard. The championships would be hosted by the North Texas LSC.

The Florida State University bid was submitted to Shannon Gillespy, who presented their bid. The FSU pool is an outdoor 50 meter pool, with a separate diving well. The pool is owned and operated by FSU. The Open Water competition would be held, but no specific information was listed on the bid form.

The dates for the 2011 competition is July 26 – July 30 (4½ days), with Open Water on July 31, 2011.

The vote on these bids will be conducted at the Friday Zone meeting.

Disability Committee

Each year the Disability Committee awards several awards. This year there are a couple of Southern Zone delegates that are nominated for the awards. Tucker Dupree (NC) is nominated for the Trischa L. Zorn Award for the Disability Swimmer of the Year. And, Fred Lamback (GA) is nominated for the Jimi Flowers Disability Coach of the Year Award.

A question was raised about what the eligibility would be for the 2010 Age Group Championships. Brian Dangelmaier presented items that were tabled from the 2008 Southern Zone Committee Meetings. After

much discussion, a motion was made to leave the Age Group Championship qualifications, ages, and events as they currently are.

Currently there are no bids for the 2010 Senior Zone Meet. The Senior Zone Task Force was directed to solicit bids for the 2010 meet and to bring those bids forth at the Friday Zone Meeting.

The Age Group Championships meet records have been updated through this year's meet and will be posted on the website shortly.

Richard raised several issues of Bylaws changes that need to be updated to bring the Bylaws current, including:

1. The addition of the Senior Zone Meet
2. The elimination of the Age Group Planning Committee
3. The corrections of references to the USA Swimming Rules & Regulations

Since these changes were not distributed 30 days prior to this meeting, a 90% vote is necessary to approve these changes. A motion was made to amend the Bylaws to update the three items above. M/S/P. Herb Schwab will update the Bylaws, as directed.

Marvin Lanphere, Scholastic All America

Marvin is the Chair of the Scholastic All America Committee. There was an increase of 50% over last year with 1494 Athletes making the Scholastic All America this year. North Carolina Swimming had the most athletes in the Southern Zone, with Georgia Swimming second, and Florida Swimming third.

Gloria Schuldt was elected by secret ballot.

Cecil Gordon, Diversity Committee Chair

Cecil Gordon made a presentation on the Diversity Summit that will be held on November 12 through November 14 in Colorado Springs. Each LSC has been invited. Each LSC will be allowed to send one delegate and USA Swimming will cover the room and board. The LSC is

responsible for travel costs. The last Summit was held in 2007. This one should be even better. Contact John Cuzak if there are any questions. Hopefully, all LSCs will be represented at this Summit.

Southern Zone Age Group Championships Evaluation Committee Report Brian Dangelmaier reported on the recommendations from the Meet Evaluation Committee.

1. Extend the entry deadline from 12:00 midnight on Sunday to 12:00 noon on Monday of the week of the meet. M/S/P
2. Amend the eligibility time standards from the 2008 US Open to the 2009 US Open (same times). M/S/P

Southern Zone Senior Championships Evaluation Committee Report Kate Chronic reported on the recommendations from the Meet Evaluation Committee.

1. Change the age criteria to 15 & Over
2. Change the Time Standards to 15-16 AAA Times
3. Time Trials available on a daily basis as time permits between Prelims and Finals
4. A/B/C Finals – option to add “D” Finals if time permits
5. Due to the size of the meet, an option to add bonus events is available
6. Open Water Events, if the Host has the availability
7. Relay Time Standards – continue with two relays per team
8. Disability Athletes – inclusion as per the current Southern Zone Age Group Handbook practice

A motion was made to accept all of the recommendations. M/S/F

A motion was made to divide the question. M/S/P

Items 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 8 passed by voice vote.

Item 4 passed by a hand count of LSCs by 10-4 vote.

No vote was taken on Item 7, since the recommendation was to continue with the current practice.

Southern Zone Senior Championships Site Nominations/Presentations Two bids were received by Kate Chronic: North Texas at the Mansfield Aquatic Center and the Orlando YMCA venue. Presentations were made by both sites.

Orlando was selected by secret ballot.

The dates of the Senior Zone Championships were recommended to be August 3 through August 7, 2010. M/S/P

The dates for 2011 were recommended to be August 2 through August 6, 2011. M/S/P

2011 Southern Zone Age Group Championships Site Selection Florida State University requested an opportunity to make a presentation for the 2011 Age Group Championship meet, since they were not present Thursday. They were allowed to make a presentation, and both North Carolina and North Texas were allowed to make a presentation, if they desired, but they declined.

Cary, North Carolina was selected by secret ballot.

Election of Junior Athlete Representative Hannah Wilson conducted the election of the Junior Athlete Representative. Nominations were made from the floor:

No candidate received a majority. A run-off was held between Claire Brandt, Rikke Bukh, and Leslie Murray (two of the candidates were tied for second).

No candidate received a majority after the first run-off. A second run-off was held between Claire Brandt and Rikke Bukh.

The two candidates were tied after the second run-off. A motion was made to elect co-Junior Athlete Representatives. M/S/P

Dave Thomas, USA Swimming Sport Development/Southern Zone Consultant Dave delivered his 2009 State of the Zone Report (attached).

Zone Disability Swimming Coordinator Glenda Orth (GA) was appointed by the Zone Directors to be the Zone Disability Swimming Coordinator.

Bylaws Review – Housekeeping Items Shannon Gillespy reviewed the Bylaws Housekeeping items that were presented and approved at Thursday's meeting. Also, "Adapted Swimming Coordinator" will be changed to "Disability Swimming Coordinator" in the Bylaws.

Proposed Bylaw Amendments Two proposals were submitted by Clark Hammond (SE) and presented by Chris Coraggio (SE):

Proposal 1: The Southern Zone Officials Chairman shall be elected for a two-year term at the USAS Convention in even-numbered years. To facilitate this transition, the Southern Zone Officials Chairman elected in 2009 shall serve a one-year term.

Rationale – This proposal would allow the Officials Chairman and the other Non-Coach representative to serve parallel terms and work on projects together for at least two years.

Motion made to accept this proposal, but died due to a lack of a Second.

Proposal 2: A person may be elected to serve as the Southern Zone Officials Chairman for a maximum of two consecutive terms (four years), after which a minimum of one year must pass before serving in that capacity again.

Rationale - We have great officials in the Southern Zone and need to provide opportunities for them to serve.

Sectional Handbook Shannon thanked all of the General Chairs, who met yesterday to make plans to develop a Sectional Handbook, similar to the Southern Zone Age Group Championship Handbook. Responses should be sent to Shannon by December 1st. Shannon will compile the responses into a draft of the Sectional Handbook.
