Jack Dowling, Disability Swimming Committee

Jack Dowling (ST), a member of the Disability Swimming Committee, is seeking support at the House of Delegates Meeting for the legislation packet pertaining to disability swimming. The guidelines that the Disability Swimming Committee is using are for promoting inclusion, and for being general and practical. The Committee is trying to remove obstacles for the referee and make the officiating of disabled swimmers easier for the officials. The proposals are designed to use standard common sense. Jack distributed copies of Article 105 and Article 105 interpretations to help meet officials. Swimmers have the right to compete, but not the guarantee of success.

2008 Southern Zone Age Group Championships, Robert Caragol

Robert thanked the Stingray Swim Club and the Georgia Tech facility for a great meet. It was a very fast meet. Five swimmers made five US Open cuts. Forty-six swimmers made 80 Junior National Cuts. Tim Bauer (GU), a member of the Senior Swimming Committee, presented the issues of the Senior Zone Meet. The Committee met in March in Colorado Springs and, with the help of George Block, the Committee developed plans for a Senior Zone Championships Meet. The intent of the Championships is to help bridge the step between Zones and Juniors. The athletes would be allowed to enter as individuals, and not as an LSC. It would be a 15 & Over meet, held in August of each year. USA Swimming would support the meet with a \$10,000 sponsorship. The Time Standards would be left up to the Zone to develop. The Senior Swimming Committee would like to do these meets in this coming year. The Senior Swimming Committee would like the 15 & Overs removed from the current Zone Meets. And, it would be left up to each Zone, if that Zone wanted to have a Senior meet. It is completely up to each Zone whether the Zone wants to have a Senior Zone Meet. The date of the Senior Zone Meet would extend the season for many of the older swimmers, who are currently using Sectionals as their end-of-season meet.
